National Highway System

The National Highway System (NHS) is an interconnected system of routes that serve important national functions, e.g., security, commerce, and travel. The NHS is comprised of Interstate and defense routes, other principal arterial routes, and routes connecting to major intermodal facilities such as airports, ports, and ferry terminals. With a few exceptions, all NHS routes in Alaska are owned by ADOT&PF.
